- **En-suite available** (except for both Towers)



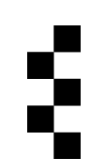

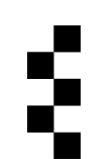

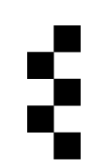

- **Big Essex Award** – get achievements recognised and added to **HEAR**, embedded with **Chart My Path** (platform to find and track extra-curricular opportunities)

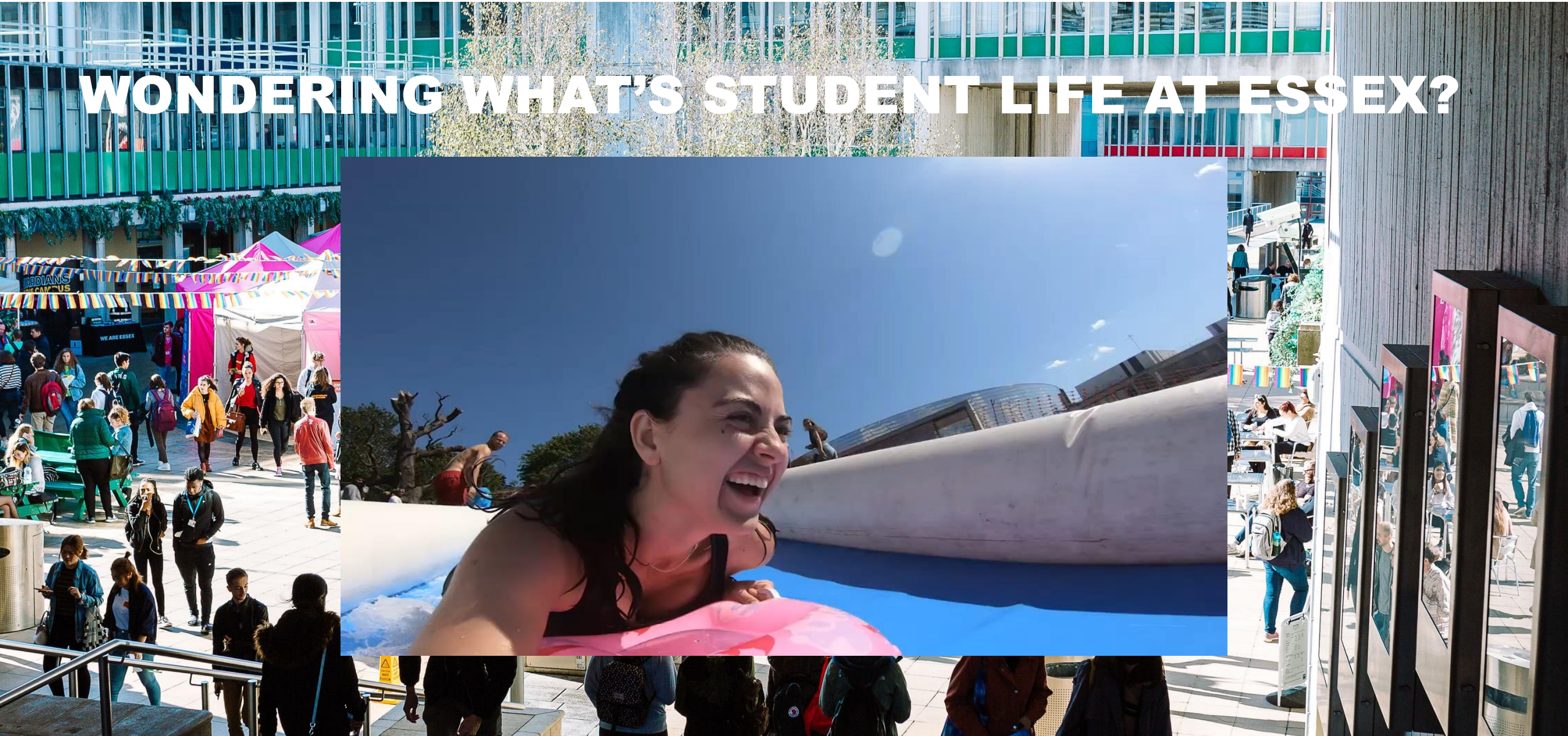
